

Singers at USG

10/1/2021 update

These rules are subject to modification, in the best judgment of USG's leaders, as the public health situation evolves and government guidance is updated.

It is recognized that even with precautions, there may be exposure to COVID when singing at USG. Additionally, no vaccine is 100 percent effective, and there remains a risk that fully vaccinated individuals will nonetheless contract COVID. The Music Director must remind all participants of this risk when they choose to participate. Participation is an acknowledgement of this risk.

General health requirement

Please stay home if you are feeling unwell or have been exposed to somebody who has had a positive test for COVID or suspected COVID within the past two weeks. If you are fully vaccinated and had a negative COVID test 3 to 5 days after your exposure, you are clear to attend.

Vaccination requirement

All singers at USG must be fully vaccinated and must have provided prior proof of vaccination.

No indoor singing at this time

We hope this will change when we are able to move to indoor worship.

Outdoor singing

- No congregational singing at this time. Humming is permitted.
- Singing as a part of the presentation of the worship service is allowed as follows:
 - Unmasked – at least 10 feet apart from each other and anyone else
 - Masked – at least 6 feet apart from each other and 8 feet from anyone else
