COVID Vaccination Requirements

10/22/2021

Following are USG COVID vaccination requirements and recommendations:

Singers who participate in USG worship services

When singing is permitted, all singers who participate in USG worship services must be fully vaccinated. This includes the choir, soloists, etc. A vaccination card will be required as proof of vaccination. The Music Director will check the status of all singers and will keep a record of who has confirmed vaccination.

This requirement does not address congregational singing.

Persons who work with USG children and youth

All USG staff members and volunteers who work in-person with children and youth on USG-related activities must be fully vaccinated. A vaccination card will be required as proof of vaccination. The Director of Spiritual Development (DSD) will check the status of all volunteers and all employees who report to the DSD, and will keep a record of who has confirmed vaccination. The Church Administrator will keep a record of the vaccination status of all staff.

USG staff

At the time of this protocol, all current USG staff are fully vaccinated.

On September 28, 2021, the Board passed a motion that “all new hires to USG be fully vaccinated against Covid 19 within 2 months after employment.

Recommendation – People who attend USG in person (Approved by MASC and Board President Andrea Barsevick 10/21/2021):

USG welcomes you to in-person or Zoom services every Sunday. We recommend that everyone who comes to the church be fully vaccinated, if eligible. Children who are not yet eligible to be vaccinated may attend with parents or adult family members. We warmly invite you to join us on Zoom if you are not fully vaccinated. And please get vaccinated if you are eligible.
