#### **COVID Safety Protocols Based on Community Risk Level**

Revised November 10, 2022

USG is following a predetermined set of COVID safety steps that may vary as the COVID community risk level rises or falls. To determine risk level, we will rely on the CDC's Community Risk Level for Philadelphia County Pa, which is updated every Thursday by 8pm (<a href="https://covid.cdc.gov/covid-data-tracker/#county-view?list\_select\_state=Pennsylvania&data-type=CommunityLevels&list\_select\_county=42101">https://covid.cdc.gov/covid-data-type=CommunityLevels&list\_select\_county=42101</a>).

The COVID Task Force has decided that in view of the trajectory of COVID over the summer and the reduced risk of death COVID poses to vaccinated people, we will now wait until the risk level changes for two consecutive weeks before implementing any changes to USG protocols. When the risk level is high on two Fridays in a row, for example, the high-risk protocol will be implemented that very Sunday. These protocols will apply to USG events. *Rentals are subject to different requirements*.

USG's COVID safety requirements will continue to be revised according to the best judgment of USG leaders as the public health situation evolves and governmental policies are updated. The requirements are subject to change without notice. Even with precautions, it is possible that there may be exposure to COVID-19 at USG. Participants acknowledge this risk when choosing to meet at USG.

#### **COVID Safety at USG**

USG asks all who wish to attend services and other activities in person to be immunized as per CDC recommendations. If you are not immunized or have impaired immunity, please participate online or wear a mask at all times when you are indoors. If you are feeling unwell, including new onset of cough, nasal or sinus symptoms, sore throat, or other COVID symptoms, please stay home and participate in online activities.

Effective Nov 13, 2022, masks are optional when Philadelphia is at the low or medium community risk level as designated by CDC. Masks are required indoors if you recently have been exposed to someone with COVID. Masks will be required for everyone if the community risk level for Philadelphia returns to high.

## **COVID safety requirements by community risk level**

Below is a summary chart of the current requirements at different community risk levels. *Please note the following:* 

- When changes will be implemented: We will wait for two weeks of consistent change to the CDV Community Risk Level for Philadelphia. Previously it was one week.
- Masks: Optional anywhere in the building when Philadelphia is at the low or medium community risk level. There is an exception; masks are required if you have been exposed to someone with COVID or COVID symptoms. Masks are still required everywhere at the high-risk level.

- **Distance:** Distance requirements have been eliminated at all levels. We will still be respectful of individual preferences.
- Capacity: Capacity limits remain at high risk. There are no capacity limits at low or medium risk
- **Food and beverages**: There are no restrictions at low and medium risk levels. No food/beverages at high risk.
