### **Announcement From the Board of Trustees**

Your Board of Trustees has invited you to a **Listening Circle on February 8, 2026 in the Sullivan Chapel**.

In a Listening Circle, participants sit in a physical circle to symbolize connection, equality, and the absence of hierarchy. A talking piece (such as a feather or small object) is passed around; only the person holding it speaks, while everyone else listens without interrupting. People may share as much or as little as they wish, or they may pass and simply listen. Each contribution is treated as equally important; no one person's views are ranked above another's.

One key feature is a set of clear guidelines which we agree on at the start. We will be adhering to the USG Covenant of Right Relations which will be provided at the beginning of the session.

Please finish your lunch in the Edna Jones Room before coming to the Sullivan Chapel. Because the process is structured, it will begin promptly at noon and will last until 1:15 PM. To avoid disruptions once the circle is closed, latecomers will not be admitted after 12:15. You will be expected to stay the entire time.
